Rotary Club of Plainsboro, New Jersey/Global Organization of People of Indian Origin conducted a free medical camp

Plainsboro, NJ, 11.7.09 — The Rotary Club of Plainsboro, New Jersey (RCPNJ) and Global Organization of People of Indian Origin (GOPIO) of Central Jersey conducted a free medical camp at Durga Mandir in South Brunswick, NJ on Saturday, November 07, 2009

A panel of 14 doctors from different disciplines volunteered their valuable time to provide services for about 200 visitors who came for a free medical check up. Talking to one such visitor, we found that he had brought his family from Connecticut just to get them checked. During this time when heavy debate is going on healthcare reforms, it's obvious that there are many individuals and families still living without adequate health coverage.

RCPNJ/GOPIO jointly conducted the medical camp. One such camp was also conducted last year. The President of RCPNJ Mr. Darshan Doshi and President of GOPIO Central Jersey, Dr. Rajeev Mehta have decided to continue the tradition and will be conducting the joint medical camp every year.

Accurate Diagnostic Labs provided free coupons for blood and other tests. Volunteers from the South Asian Total Initiative (SATHI) conducted a survey and provided valuable health information for all the visitors who came for their medical checkup.
